

TEXT PURCHASE OPTIONS

What should you buy and where? Either the SBCC bookstore or online at the publishers site are the two main locations for purchasing course materials. I don't keep track of prices so you will have to check on the price differences between the two sites. Regardless of how and where you purchase the required materials, this course ***requires that you purchase an access code for the Hawkes Learning Math software*** and that same access code will give you access to an Etext. You cannot purchase just a text for this course. You do however have the choice between a Etext or a physical copy of the text.

Bookstore Options: The bookstore has two options for you.

1. Option 1: Buy the bundle in the SBCC bookstore. It contains the 3rd edition *Beginning Statistics* Text by Warren, Denley & Atchley and the Hawkes access code to the online software. The online software also includes the Etext. **YOU HAVE ALL THAT YOU NEED!**
2. Option 2: This option is only the Hawkes access code. A hard copy text is not included in this option however the Hawkes access code contains the Etext. The code is required for taking quizzes and working online homework (called certifies in Hawkes). The code will also give access to the Etext. This would be the cheaper of the two options.

Publisher Site Option: Buy either the text and the access code or buy just the access code which also contains the Etext. It's your choice. Personally, I like to have a hard copy of the text but it's your choice.

Regardless of the option chosen above, you will also need a TI 84 calculator. Other versions might work but the TI 84 is the best for this class. I might not be much help with other versions since I'm not very familiar with them.

Keep one thing in mind, the Hawkes Access Code <u>CANNOT BE SHARED</u> between two or more students. You must have your own.
